KAR 91-40-1:

Orthopedic Impairment: means a severe orthopedic impairment that adversely affects a child’s educational performance and includes impairments caused by:
1) congenital anomaly, such as clubfoot or absence of a limb; **2)** disease, such as poliomyelitis or bone tuberculosis; and **3)** other causes such as cerebral palsy, amputation, and fractures or burns that cause contractures

▪ medical information provides evidence of orthopedic impairment					
▪ information substantiates an impairment caused by: congenital anomaly, such as club foot or absence of a limb; disease, such as poliomyelitis or bone tuberculosis; and, other causes such as cerebral palsy, amputation, and fractures or burns that cause contractures					
▪ there is a history of orthopedic impairment					
▪ motor skills are much below that of peers					
▪ resources beyond those available in general education are required for student to demonstrate adequate progress					
▪ condition adversely affects the child’s participation and progress in the general curriculum or participation in age-appropriate activities
